You Must:

Behaviour & Support

- Encourage your child to:
 - Play fairly
 - Respect others
 - Enjoy cricket
- Support all players, not just your own child

Respect

- Respect:
 - Coaches
 - Volunteers
 - Officials
 - Other parents and players

Safeguarding Responsibilities

- Report any concerns about:
 - Welfare
 - Behaviour
 - Safety
- Follow club safeguarding procedures

Practical Responsibilities

- Ensure:
 - Children are dropped off and collected on time
 - Emergency contact details are up to date
- Inform the club of:
 - Medical needs
 - Additional support requirements

You Must Not:

- Use abusive, aggressive, or discriminatory language
- Undermine coaches or officials
- Put pressure on children to perform
- Engage in bullying (including sideline behaviour or WhatsApp groups)

Breach of Code

Breaches may result in:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Removal from club activities
